## GENERAL INFORMATION / RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee is \$15 per class, for Pre-Entries, payable BEFORE a number is issued. Pre-entries will be accepted over the phone to the number above or via email, with the assumption that said pre-entries will be paid in full at the time the entrants number is picked up.
2. Pre-Entries close on the **Thursday** preceding the show date.
3. POST Entry fees are \$20 per class. The One Minute rule will be enforced for post entrants (see rule # 6).
4. There is a general \$2.00 fee for each number issued. Riders get numbers in Equitation; horses get numbers in the Hunter, Jumper, and Pleasure.
5. The show will begin at **9:00AM**, rain or shine, unless otherwise publicized
6. Entrants have ONE MINUTE to enter the show ring after their class is called, after which the ring will be closed and the rider/horse will forfeit their class entry fee. It is the responsibility of the entrant to be aware of the horse show schedule (see schedule in this publication).
7. This is a Schooling Show so strict enforcement of proper English show attire will *not* be in place. However, jodhpurs or breeches, and boots are encouraged.
8. All Juniors (14 and under) are REQUIRED to wear an ASTM/SEI approved safety riding helmet while working around and/or riding their pony/horse, as per New York State law.
9. Braided manes and tails are not required.
10. Schooling will be allowed in the rings before the show starts and in any ring not in use during the show. Proper ring etiquette in the schooling ring is expected. Disrespectful riders/trainers will be excused from the ring.
11. NO ONE is to approach the judge under ANY circumstances. The Ring Steward will take requests to consult the judge. The judge will grant said requests at her discretion, as her judging schedule allows.

the courses posted on the show grounds, and be at the start of the show.

Pleasure Horse will be posted on the show grounds and be available at the secretary's desk at the beginning of the show.

14. Equitation classes may be split into Junior and Adult sections if entries warrant.
15. Hunter classes may be combined if there are less than three entries.
16. Management reserves the right to move classes from one ring to another pending footing, entries and/or scheduling.
17. There will be 10-minute warm-up sessions for O/F classes. See Schedule for specific warm-up sessions. Entrants are expected to comply with the directions of the Ring Steward and/or Gatekeeper with regards to these warm-up sessions.
18. Classes will have ribbons awarded to places one through six. All blue ribbon winners will also receive a prize with their ribbon.
19. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded as per total points for ribbons received in each class of a division.

20. The GRAND CHAMPION for the day will be awarded to the horse/rider who totaled the highest overall point total for the day for all divisions entered, and RESERVE Grand Champion will be awarded to the horse/rider who totaled the second highest overall point total for the day for all divisions entered.
21. HIDDEN POND HORSE SHOW SERIES YEAR END AWARDS will be given in ALL divisions.
22. To qualify for YEAR END AWARDS, entrants must have entered and participating in four out of six shows in the series.
23. Hidden Pond Stables reserves the right to double point a horseshow, towards YE awards, to resolve horseshow scheduling issues.
24. All pets must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.
25. Exhibitors are expected to treat their animals humanely. Any exhibitor using methods deemed inappropriate by the stable management or horse show management will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.
26. Questions and/or disputes of these rules or other concerns should be raised to the Horse Show Committee / Stable Management, and their decision will be FINAL.



## EQUITATION

**WALK/TROT EQUITATION:** Open to anyone who has not competed in any class that required showing at a canter. May not show in any other classes, except Intro To Pleasure classes and the Halloween Costume class.

1. WALK/TROT EQ: To be judged both directions of the ring at a Walk and Trot.
2. WALK/TROT EQ: To be judged both directions of the ring at a Walk and Trot.
3. WALK/TROT EQ TEST: Riders to ride an individual Figure 8 test.
4. WALK/TROT EQ GROUND POLE: Riders to go over a ground pole.

**PRE-EQUITATION:** Open to anyone who has not shown in any other division in this, or previous, show seasons that required group canters and over fences greater than 12+

5. PRE-EQUITATION WALK/TROT: To be judged both directions of the ring.
6. PRE-EQUITATION WALK/TROT/CANTER: To be judged both directions of the ring.  
Individual canter.
7. PRE-EQUITATION OVER/FENCES: X-rail.
8. PRE-EQUITATION MEDAL: Test to be determined by the judge.

**BEGINNER EQUITATION:** Open to any one who has not shown over fences greater than 18+ in this or previous show seasons. Can be split into Junior and Adult sections if entries warrant.

9. BEGINNER EQ WALK/TROT: To be judged both directions of the ring.
10. BEGINNER EQ WALK/TROT/CANTER: To be judged both directions of the ring.  
Individual canter.
11. BEGINNER EQ OVER/FENCES: X-rails, 12+18+
12. BEGINNER EQ MEDAL: Test to be posted.

**PRE-NOVICE EQUITATION:** .Open to any one who has not shown over fences greater than 18+ in this or previous show seasons. Can be split into Junior and Adult sections if entries warrant.

13. PRE-NOVICE EQ W/T/C: To be judged both directions of the ring.
14. PRE-NOVICE EQ OVER FENCES: Fences 12-18+
15. PRE-NOVICE EQ OVER FENCES: Fences 12-18+
16. PRE-NOVICE EQ MEDAL: Test to be posted.

**NOVICE EQUITATION:** Open to any one who has not shown in any divisions in this, or previous show seasons, that required showing over fences higher than 2q Can be split into Junior and Adult sections if entries warrant.

34. GREEN HUNTER U/S: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. No hand gallop.

35. GREEN HUNTER HACK: To be judged under saddle at a walk, trot, canter; then asked to jump two fences.

**SCHOOLING HUNTER:** Open to any pony or horse. Mount to be judged on manners, way of going, and suitability for purpose.

## PLEASURE HORSE

### Intro to horses in English or Western tack

**INTRO PLEASURE HORSE:** These are Walk/Trot/Jog only classes, great for the novice Junior/Adult rider (except Leadline); or novice horse/pony who wants to try the Pleasure Division. WALK/TROT Division entrants may enter these classes.

20. **INTRO PLEASURE HORSE UNDER SADDLE:** To be judged at a walk, trot/jog in both directions of the ring. Horse to be judged on suitability for the rider and manners.
22. **INTRO HORSEMANSHIP:** To be judged on a walk, trot/jog pattern (test). Pattern (test) to be posted on the day of the show.
24. **INTRO COMMAND CLASS:** To be judged at a walk, trot/jog both directions of the ring. Immediacy and accuracy in following the change of gaits, as called by the ring steward, to count. May be asked to halt and/or back.
26. **INTRO TRAIL CLASS:** (To be held only if there are 10 pre-entries.) To be judged individually around or through a simple course of obstacles. Trail course to be posted on the day of the show

**PLEASURE HORSE:** Open to ponies and horses, Juniors (except Leadline), and Adults. WALK/TROT Division entrants should enter Intro To Pleasure classes.

21. **PLEASURE HORSE UNDER SADDLE:** To be judged at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the ring. Horse to be judged on suitability for the rider and manners.
23. **HORSEMANSHIP:** To be judged on a pattern/test to be posted the day of the show.
25. **COMMAND CLASS:** To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Immediacy and accuracy in following the change of gaits, as called by the ring steward, to count. May be asked to halt and/or back.
27. **TRAIL CLASS:** (To be held only if there are 10 pre-entries.) To be judged individually around or through a simple course of obstacles. Trail course to be posted on the day of the show

## JUMPERS

**PUDDLE JUMPER:** Open to all ponies and horses. To be shown over fences not to exceed 2q with changes of direction. For all classes, touches not to count.
